The Board Director will further develop and implement the strategy for this area of the BEF's work and budget to support it. The successful candidate will be elected by and responsible to the BEF Council, representing the Federation's thirteen member bodies and will be supported by the BEF's executive staff. Together with the other Board Members she/he will have collective responsibility for all Federation activities.

Board Meetings will be held at Stoneleigh in Warwickshire and will take place around six times a year.

This position is voluntary but offers the opportunity for close involvement in an exciting phase of the development of equestrian sport. Knowledge, therefore, of the equestrian industry or of another sport, whilst not essential, will be an advantage.
