### **Section 3 – Summary**

*The main objective of the BEV Committee is to widen the participation in vaulting, develop the potential and achieve excellence. This process has already begun to bear fruit with an increase this year in the number of Clubs, psrticularly in the RDAan increase in the number of competitions and higher placings in International Competitions than ever achieved before.*

*Emphasis will be placed on increasing participation within Riding Centres, in particular, Pony Club Centres. It is essential to develop awareness of the value of vaulting as a fundamental basis for good riding and for developing the long term athlete. This must be written into the BEF LTAD plan. This will bring enormous benefits to the Federation on a longer term by Improving standards of seat, balance and co-ordination.. It will also benefit the equine industry in general by encouraging large numbers of potential riders.*

*It already contributes in a small way to all the Government's Agenda and is very keen to increase this contribution through its work with RDA, Skills active programmes and Pony Club Centres. The most important requirement to carry this out is to increase the number of qualified coaches which will in turn increase the accessibility of the sport.*
